Statistical Process Control or not, on GD & T Criteria

This presentation will discuss some of the more common geometrical dimensioning & tolerancing symbols and whether or not we should be applying SPC on them. There will be reflections on the current situation in industry today.

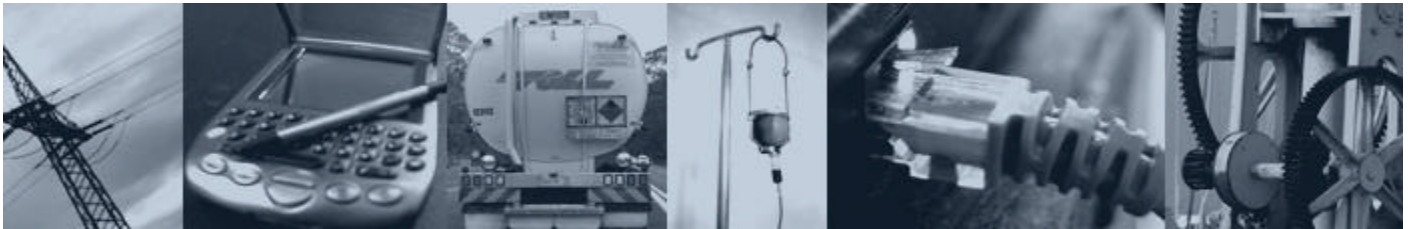
